Under age 3: read highlighted only and skip review questions

1. This is a prayer from the Bible, in Psalm 139. It says,

“Lord, You know all about me. You know when I sit down and when I get up. You know my thoughts before I think them. You know where I go and where I lie down. You know *everything* I do.

Review Question: What does God know about you? (everything, when you sit down and get up, your thoughts before you think them, where you go and where you lie down)



2. Lord, even before I say a word, you already know what I am going to say. You are all around me—in front and in back. You have put your hand on me. You know way more than I can understand!

Review Question: Does God know what you are going to say before you even say it out loud? (yes)

Review Question: Does God know more than all of us? (yes, he knows more than we can understand or think about)



3. Where can anyone go to get away from you? Where can someone run away from you, God? Nowhere! You are in the skies up high, and everywhere down low. Even darkness cannot hide me from you. You see everything, even in the dark.

Review Question: Can someone run away from God where he won't see them? (no- God is everywhere and he sees everything, even in the dark)



4. God, you made all of me. I praise you and thank you, because you made me in an amazing and wonderful way. You know all the days of my life already before they have even happened!

Review Question: Who made you? (God- and he made you in an amazing way, he knows everything about your life)



5. God, your thoughts are so special to me. I know you can see the good and the bad things in my heart. Please look at all my thoughts and change my wrong ideas into right ones, so I can be more like you. Help me follow your good and right ways, God.”

Review Question: Can God see the good and bad things in your thoughts and heart? (yes)

Review Question: If we ask him to, will God help us change our wrong ideas into right ones that are good and right? (yes- God wants us help us follow his ways and become more like him)
