Icebreaker: Who is someone that has been very influential in your life and how have they influenced you?

Context: Jesus has been going about teaching, healing, and casting out demons. His fame is spreading all through the land. He has many followers with large crowds going everywhere he goes. However, Jesus knows the success of his ministry depends on him investing in a few people who will take his message and Kingdom to the world.

Passage: Read Mark 3:13-19 and then pray.

Bible Discussion

1. Before Jesus made an important decision, he got away from distractions in order to pray. What can we learn from Jesus' example?
2. In v.14 we see that Jesus first wants his disciples to be with him before he sends them out. Why is that important?
3. What does it look like to be in a personal relationship with Jesus?
4. How can being with Jesus motivate you to share Jesus with others?
5. Jesus' disciples were young and came from various backgrounds. They were fisherman, tax collectors, political activists, and even a traitor. What can we learn about Jesus from the types of people he disciplined?
6. Have you been disciplined before? What was your experience like?
7. Have you disciplined someone before? What was your experience?

6. Who are people in your life that Jesus might be sending you to?
7. What next step do you sense Jesus is inviting you to take?

Gospel Connection

Every follower of Christ is called to be with Jesus. It's from our being with Jesus that He empowers his followers to declare and display the gospel in their everyday lives. The Gospel is the declaration that God has delivered his people from the penalty of sin, the power of sin, and will one day ride the universe of the presence of sin.
